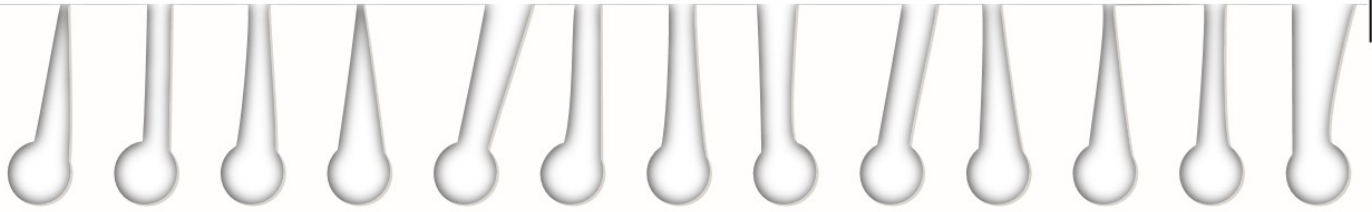
"Chefs who have checked-in for the fourth floor";

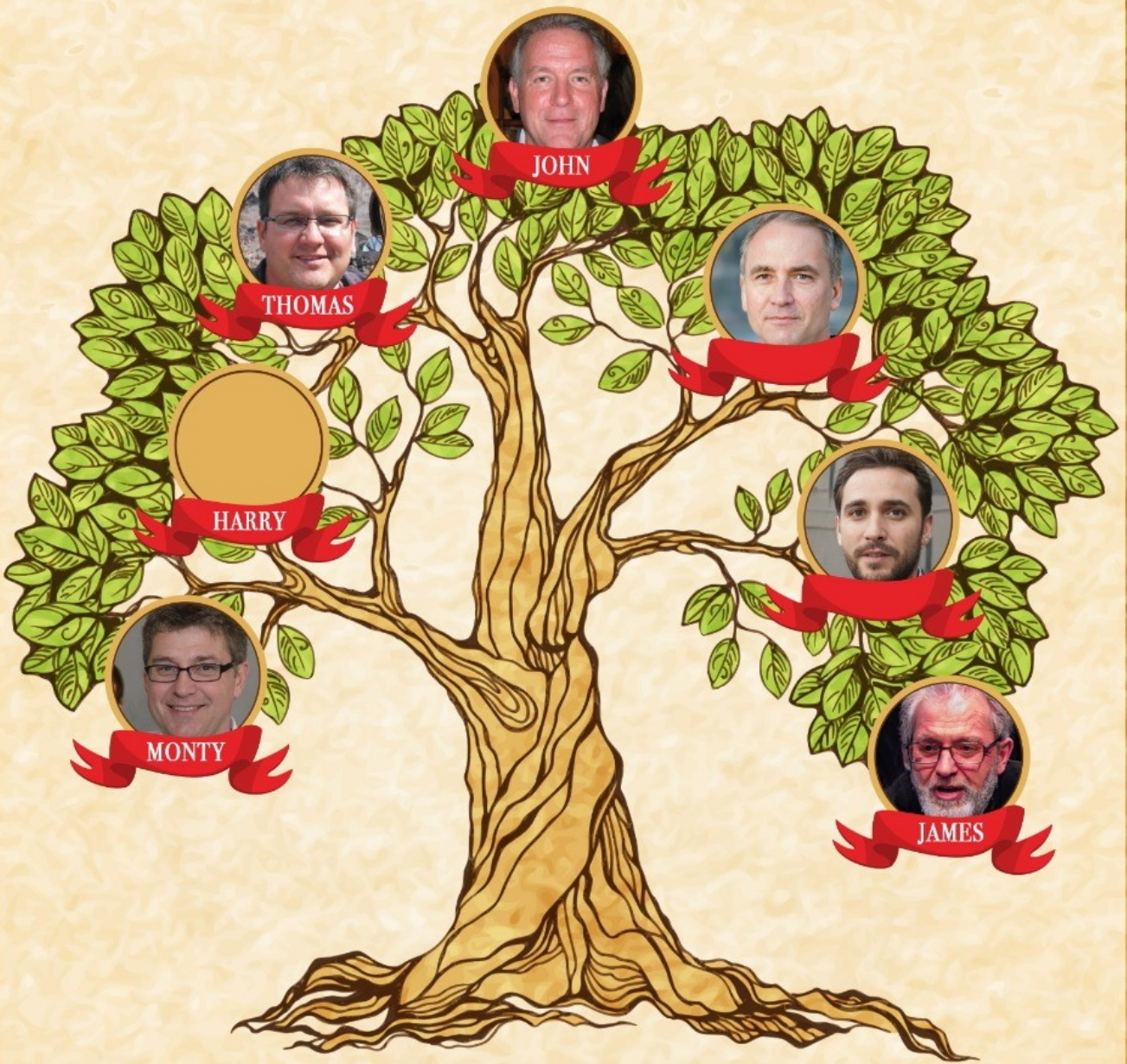
